Tasting on the Terrace proceeds benefit The Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) of Family and Youth-www.fyca.org. According to Darkness to Light's "Stewards of Children" report, 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys, in the nation, are sexually abused prior to age 18... that's 2 kids in 10 – 20% of the population. In 2015, Family and Youth's CAC saw 655 children in Southwest Louisiana, who were reported to have been severely sexually molested or physically abused. The CAC is a child-friendly facility designed to coordinate services for these children. Designed and managed to reduce the effects of trauma, the CAC's staff work together with area prosecutors, law enforcement agents, social service workers, therapists, victim advocates and medical professionals to investigate child abuse allegations and reduce
